**CAPITAL REGION WATER AND PARTNERS ORGANIZING A GREAT HARRISBURG  
VOLUNTEER CLEANUP IN SOUTH HARRISBURG**

HARRISBURG (April 25, 2014): As one of many cleanups held citywide during the Great Harrisburg Cleanup, Capital Region Water will be leading a volunteer cleanup in South Harrisburg near the site of last month's water main leaks and sinkholes on South 14<sup>th</sup> Street.

Last year, the Great Harrisburg Cleanup brought together over 500 volunteers who filled 21 dumpsters with litter and bulk trash from illegal dumping sites throughout Harrisburg.

"We want to do this for the residents", said Capital Region Water CEO Shannon Williams, "they've been through a lot and litter not only adds blight to a neighborhood but it's also a source of pollution in our local waters."

LCSWMA is waiving the tipping fee for all litter and waste collected during the event as well as donating safety vests and litter bags for the volunteers.
