HARRISBURG (March 6, 2015) – Capital Region Water has lifted the Boil Water Advisory today for 16 homes between 226 and 242 and 275, 277, 279 Hamilton Street in Harrisburg, PA.

The advisory went into place Wednesday (3/4) due to a loss of positive pressure during a water main repair.
