CAPITAL REGION WATER WINS BEST TASTING WATER IN PENNSYLVANIA

ANNUAL WATER QUALITY REPORT RELEASED; WATER SUPPLIED IN 2015 BETTER THAN ALL FEDERAL AND STATE DRINKING WATER STANDARDS

HARRISBURG (June 28, 2016): Capital Region Water's 2016 Drinking Water Quality Report is now available to its customers. This report summarizes water quality tests from the previous year and announces that Capital Region Water recently won Pennsylvania's Best Tasting Water. Organized by the Pennsylvania Section of the American Water Works Association (PA-AWWA), the Best of Pennsylvania Taste Test featured water from nine water suppliers located throughout Pennsylvania. Capital Region Water, with water sourced from the DeHart Reservoir, placed first overall after judging by attendees at PA-AWWA's annual conference and an expert panel.
